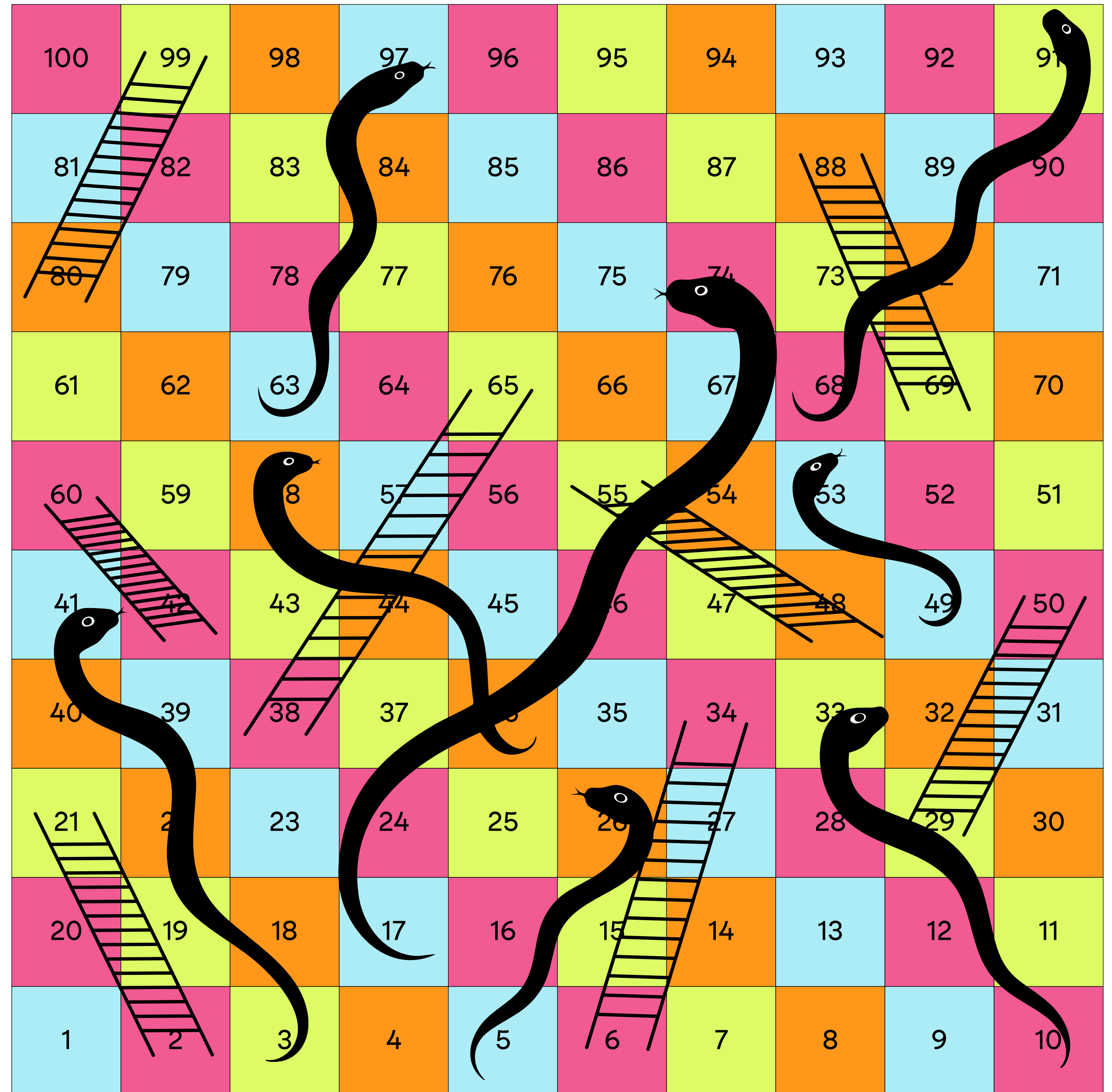

# How to Play

- ① Prepare the board:
  - ↳ all players must start on the first tile
  - ↳ shuffle all quiz cards
  - ↳ the youngest player starts
- ② Roll the dice and walk the number shown (each player must only roll the dice once for each round)
- ③ If you land on a serpent or ladder tile, one of your opponents must read a question from the Quiz Cards
- ④ Your next move depends on whether you get the question right or wrong
  - ↳ if you get a question right on a ladder tile, you go up the ladder
  - ↳ if you get a question wrong on a ladder tile, you remain on that tile
  - ↳ if you get a question right on a serpent tile, you remain on that tile
  - ↳ if you get a question wrong on a serpent tile, you slip down the serpent
