

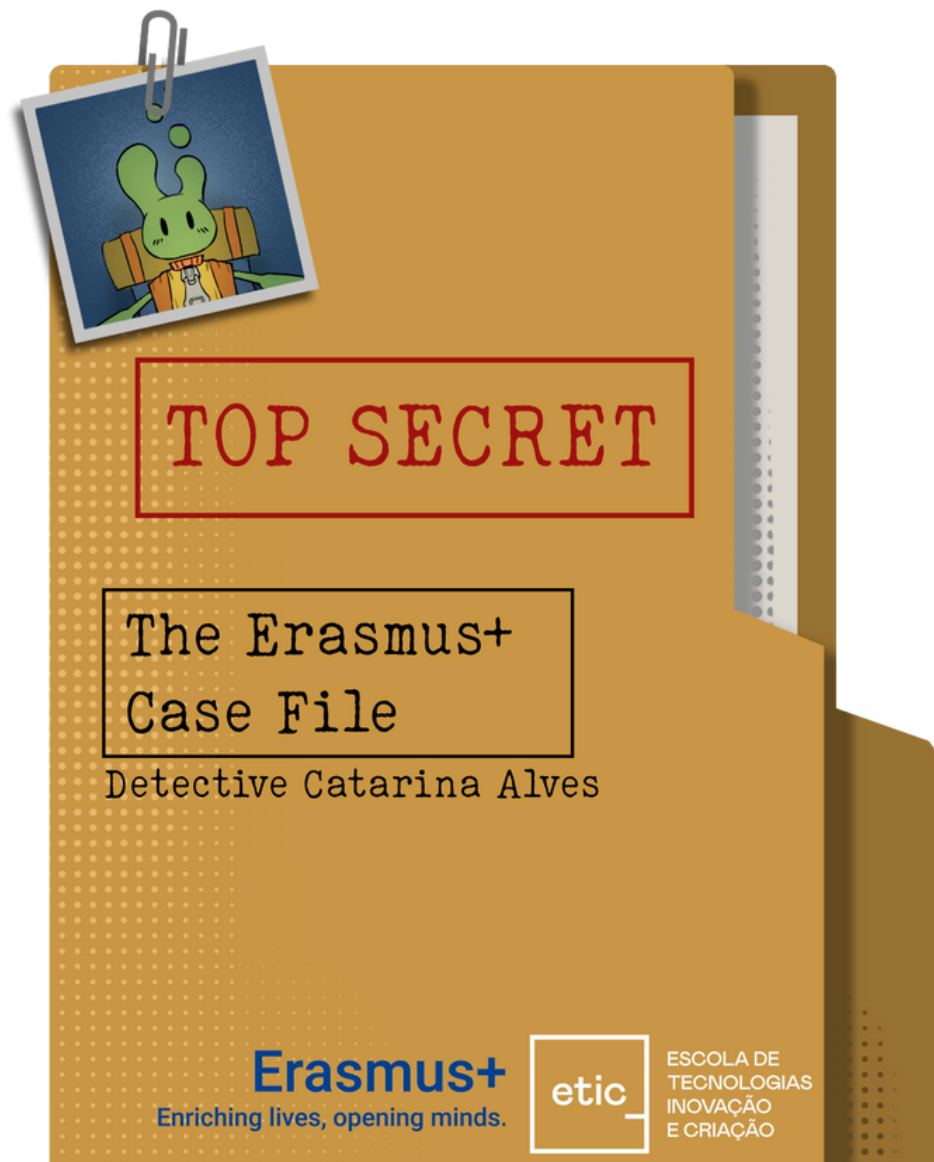

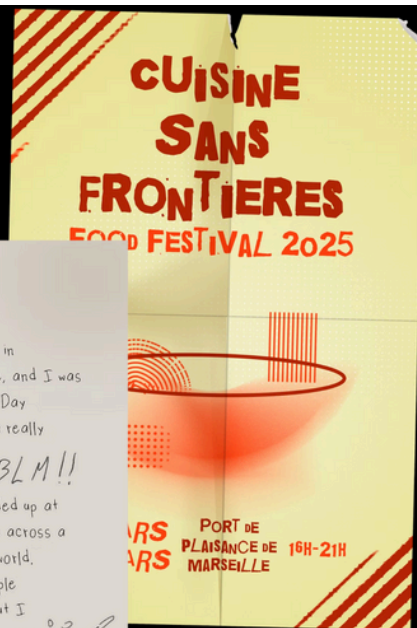
21 March

Stockholm, Sweden

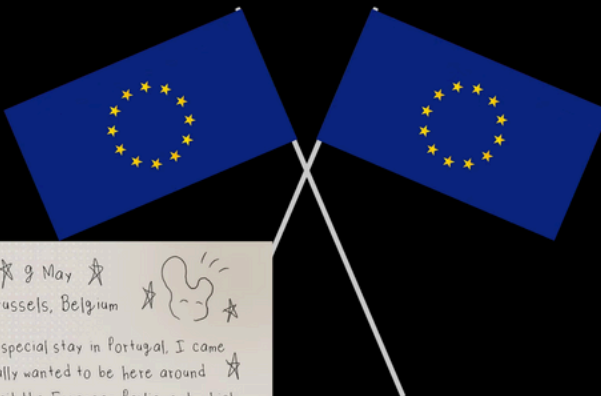

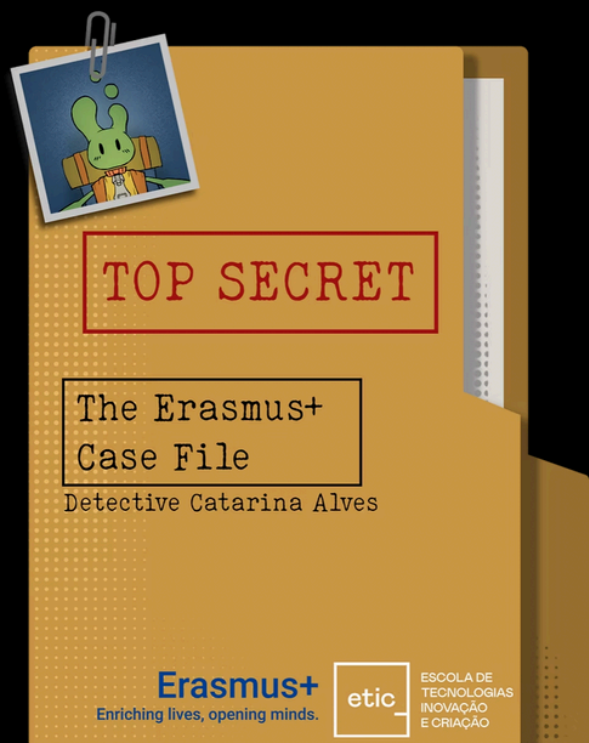
